Required Steps to Obtain Your Credential	1.	Successfully complete requirements for WDTC's EMS 101 course.
	2.	Successfully pass the National Registry of Emergency Medical Technicians (NREMT) Psychomotor Exam.
	3.	Successfully pass the National Registry of Emergency Medical Technicians (NREMT) Written Exam.
	4.	Apply for SD EMT credential through the South Dakota Board of Osteopathic Examiners at <u>www.SDBMOE.gov</u> .
		NOTE: If you plan to work outside of South Dakota, you will be required to apply for certification or licensure within that state. Each state has different requirements for this process.
	5.	To maintain the EMT credential, a recertification process is required with the NREMT every 2 years by obtaining continuing education credits and maintaining CPR certification.
