	2. Determine an eligibility route (Route 1), complete the online ASCP-BOC application
	and submit the application fee.
	3. Submit the required documentation for verification of eligibility.
	NOTE: ASCP must receive official transcripts prior to receiving certification
	4. Receive approval to take the computerized exam at a Pearson ProfessionalCenter
	within a 3-month period upon exam eligibility.
	5. Schedule the exam at the Pearson Professional Center of your choice.
	NOTE: A preliminary pass/fail result will be provided at the end of the exam.
	6. Receive email notification to log in and view the final exam score report.
	NOTE: Certificate will be sent approximately 4-8 weeks after receiving passing scorereport
	7. Maintaining the certification - Initial certification is valid for 3 years. The Credential
	Maintenance Program is required every three years to maintain certification.
	NOTE: If you plan to work outside of South Dakota, you will be required to apply for registration and/or licensure within that state. Each state may have different requirements for this process.
